

# Midsummer Malvern 2017 with St Peter's Printmakers.

## CALL FOR ENTRIES.

St Peter's Printmakers and Friends will be staging an exhibition of their recent work at St Peter's Church, Cowleigh Bank, Malvern on Saturday June 17th from 10 – 4pm. This forms part of the Midsummer Malvern Festival (formerly Malvern Civic Week).

You are invited to participate by submitting (by or on Saturday June 17th) a piece of your original work, literary or graphic, for preview at the show. All original submissions will be more formally presented at St Peter's during the Worcestershire Open Studios event, held over August Bank Holiday weekend. A facsimile of the entries (printed by Aspect Design) will be presented in a folder to each participant and may be made available to the wider public.

Written pieces, prose or poetry, printed or hand-written, are accepted, as are drawings, photographs, any other 2D work, or original prints. They should reflect the theme 'Midsummer Malvern.' but can be as imaginative or experimental as you like.

During the day of June 17th the presses at St Peter's will be accessible for you to make your own relief print on the theme of Midsummer Malvern. Lino, plastic or polystyrene blocks will be available, as will tools, paper, ink and supervision. Come with an idea and see it transformed into a unique print which will form part of the collection.

### Terms and Conditions

Each entry, maximum one per entrant, should be no larger than A4 size and carry the title and the entrant's name on the back.

Entries must be accompanied by a completed Entry Form and the Entry Fee of £5 (under 16 years) / £10 (adult) and submitted by or on Saturday June 17th. Cheques should be made payable to St Peter's Printmakers.

Entries, securely packaged and clearly marked Midsummer Malvern 2017, accompanied by cheque payment (no cash), can be posted to St Peter's Church, Cowleigh Bank, Malvern WR14 1QS or delivered to the church (open daily 10am – 5pm) and placed in the collecting box at the back of the building.

Any submission deemed offensive or otherwise inappropriate may be refused.

Original pieces will, as required, (please indicate on the Entry Form) be returned to the entrants after the end of August.

Except for the printing of the facsimile edition, described above, copyright for each piece remains with the individual participant.
